Dear Supplier,

We would like to ensure the complete understanding of raw material callouts on our drawings and Yazaki's expectation....

We require you adhere to the following:

- Raw material must be ordered at the nominal value called out on the drawing
 - Any changes or modifications (including ordering material outside of nominal to the high side or low side even if it is within the specification on the drawing) require prior Yazaki approval via the SICR process
- Raw material certificates from the compounder are to be kept on file for a period of one year minimum
- Test data and sample buttons for each raw material batch received must be kept for a minimum of one year
- Control plans need to be modified to include testing of the molded product to ensure proper characteristics
 - The test frequency will be at one part per cavity per shift
 - Data must be available for inspection and kept for a minimum of one year

We would like to caution you that the end customer(s) may reject parts due to variations that are not acceptable even if you may deem acceptable. Any rejections from Yazaki or its customers due to the non-conformance will be the sole responsibility of the supplier.
