URGENT

Yazaki's compliance to our OEM customers is to assure that no Substances of Concerns (SOC) are present in our finished goods. To assure that Yazaki is compliant we must be assured that the materials/components supplied by our suppliers are absent of all SoC's.

In order for us to comply with Government and OEM requirements we are requesting the following:

- Suppliers should investigate and confirm that all IMDS submissions to Yazaki and its Affiliates have all Substances of Concern (SoC) per the Global Automotive Declarable Substance List (GADSL) reported within 72 hours of the request.
- Suppliers shall confirm that all components and materials used for Yazaki and its Affiliates DO NOT contain any of the 4 heavy metals (Lead, Mercury, Cadmium or Hexavalent Chromium) or their compounds above the allowable limits per the GADSL. If these heavy metals are used below their allowable limit and are intentionally added, they must be properly reported on the suppliers IMDS submission to Yazaki.
- Suppliers should also confirm that all components and materials used for Yazaki and its Affiliates DO NOT contain any of the Brominated Flame Retardants (PBB/PBDE) per the GADSL.
- Finally – A letter from your company stating that the above has been performed and that you are 100% in compliance to these requirements. This letter is to be printed on your company's letter head and signed by the appropriate authority within you organization.

Yazaki understands this request may be labor intensive and time consuming dependant on the amount of parts you supply, but it is imperative this be completed.

We ask for compliance to this request no later then April 7th, 2006.
