Dear Supplier,

The Purchasing Department has recently discovered that there are differences in the interpretation of the part weight that is reported on the PSW and on IMDS. Yazaki requires parts to be weighed in accordance with the guidelines of AIAG. The guidelines stipulate suppliers are to record part weights as follows:

- The part weight is the weight of the part as shipped, measured and expressed in kilograms to four decimal places (0.0000)
- The weight shall not include shipping protectors, assembly aids or packaging material (including carrier strips and anything that would be discarded at Yazaki or at the customer during processing/manufacturing)
- The part weight is calculated by individually weighing ten randomly selected parts and reporting the average of their weights

Yazaki is not mandating the resubmission of the PPAPs that were submitted with incorrectly reported part weights. However, suppliers may choose to resubmit PPAP to correct part weights. Yazaki also maintains the ability to request resubmission of parts due to discrepancies in part weight at our discretion.

Moving forward, all submitted PPAPs must contain the correct part weight in accordance with the AIAG standard. If you have any questions, please contact your buyer or SQE.
